

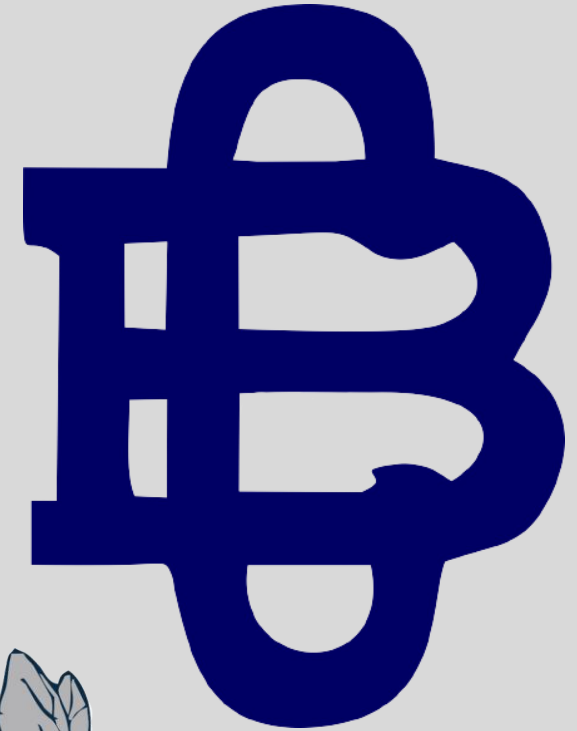
Feature Story Kenly Statler
